This table is at the entrance of the library. Sometimes someone will say hello to me when I come in.



Most patrons will wear face masks.



This is where I can return anything I borrowed from the library. Arrows show me which way to walk and to wait for my turn.



This is how I know someone works or volunteers at the library. They are always available for help.




If I want to check out materials, someone in my family or me needs to have a library card. They might look like this:



I can use the displays and shelves to help me find new materials for checkout.

This is how I can find a bathroom to use.





I can use a self-check kiosk to check-out materials myself, or I can follow the signs and arrows to check-out materials at the front desk.



Signs will show me how to find the library exit.
