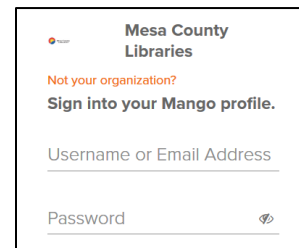
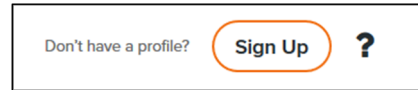



## FIRST STEPS:

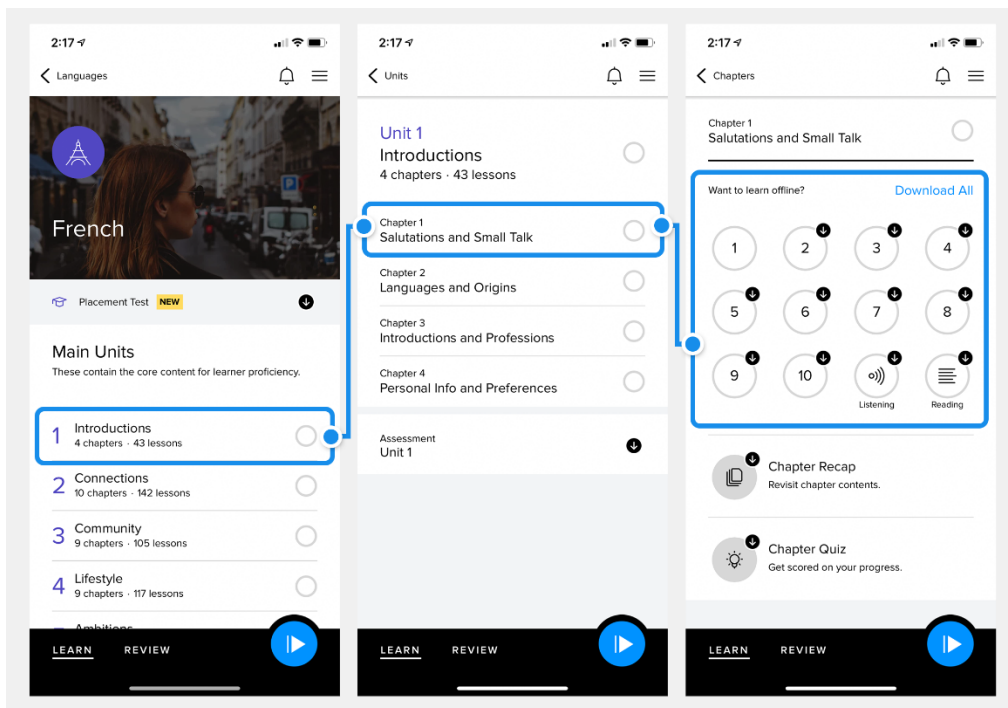
