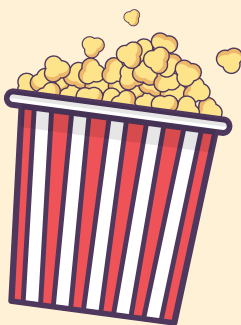


Team Building Challenges with The LEGO Guy
