Using Your Badge Book



The goal for Summer Reading is to **earn 1500 points** and while doing so, earn online badges, stickers in your badge book, a book bag and free books, and more!

Your Badge Book was created to work hand-in-hand with Beanstack.

What do I do to earn points?

You will earn points for:

- Reading 1 point per minute
- Reviewing a Book/Audiobook 20 points per review
- Discovering Something New 5 points per discovery
- Completing Badge Book Activities 10 points per activity
- Achieving personal reading goals 50 points per goal (limit 100 points)

How do I log my points?

Register for a Beanstack by visiting **mesacountylibraries.beanstack.org** or by downloading the Beanstack Tracker app to a mobile device. If you need help registering for a Beanstack account, visit any Mesa County Libraries location or call us at 970-243-4442. Once you have an account, you can log reading and activities in Beanstack and the software will keep track of your points and notify you when you've earned rewards by appropriate milestones.

Don't want to use Beanstack?

Log your reading and activities in your Badge Book. Then call or visit any Mesa County Libraries location to have library staff enter your reading and activities into Beanstack. Be sure your reading and activities are logged in Beanstack by **July 15**!

How do I log my reading using only my Badge Book?

Every day you read, you get a sticker. The amount of reading to earn the sticker is completely up to you. You can set a goal for minutes or pages per day. Once you've completed your daily reading, just peel off a "Daily Reader" sticker and stick it in your daily reading log! Then write the number of minutes or pages you read under your sticker. When you've read 5 days in a row, give yourself a "Streak Week" sticker.

How do I log other activities that will give me points using only my Badge Book?

- Book/Audiobook Reviews Because reviews are meant to be shared with your peers, we are only set up to accept book reviews via Beanstack. You can enter written reviews or upload a picture review using either the web or app version of Beanstack.
- Discovering Something New When you make a new discovery, record 5 extra points in your reading log under your "Daily Reader" sticker.
- Badge Book Activities When you complete an activity, add your badge sticker to any of the sticker pages (p. 23, 26-27, 30, 33, 37, 41-42, 44-45, 48-49) and note how the sticker was earned. Record 10 extra points in your reading log under your "Daily Reader" sticker.
- Personal Reading Goals Use page 23 of your Badge Book to record your personal goal. Once you've reached your goal, record your points in your reading log under your "Daily Reader" sticker.

Be sure your reading and activities are logged in Beanstack by July 15 to earn all your prizes. Check in with us when you've earned 250 points, 875 points, and 1500 points to get your prizes. All prizes available while supplies last. The last day to pick up your prizes is July 31, 2023
