4	<ul> <li>Summary of the Nomination and Election Process for Board Officers</li> <li>The Committee is allowed by the bylaws to make nominations for officers but cannot nominate them until the upcoming Board of Trustees meeting so long as there is a quorum present.</li> <li>The officer positions are for President, Vice President, and Secretary.</li> <li>There is a two year term limit.</li> <li>The BoT tries to not elect members as President who are in their last year of their BoT term.</li> </ul>
